



## Nymans Gardens

Contract Value: £250,000

After completion of a timber and stone pergola for the National Trust at Nymans Gardens, the R.B. Group returned to restore the mansion ruins, completing a complex project with a large unstable structure on a vast basement. Structural work involved removing the large concrete lintel in the existing structure and casting insitu new reinforced concrete beams.

Other operations required the replacement of the corroded RSJ's with Stainless steel universal beams imported from Germany. Stone and timber restoration was also carried out on the building.
